### **How to find us:**

The Resort is in the Cypress Hills Provincial Park. Make your way to Maple Creek on the Trans Canada Highway #1, and go south 40 km's. In the course of a half hour, you will rise from flat prairie by over 2,000 ft., into dense forest with lookout points enjoying majestic views in all directions. Coming from the USA? You could make your way to Havre & take US 233 (St. Joe Road) north to the border. Cross the border & the highway turns into Hwy 21. Head straight north to the Cypress Hills Provincial Park.

#### **Cypress Hills Resort:**



We have booked the entire Cypress Hills Resort which has a combination of Hotel Rooms, 2 BDR Townhouses with a pullout couch in the living room, and 1, 2 and 3 bedroom Cabins. In total, there are 65 units, and as well, there are full campground facilities available.

Despite the fact that we have the entire complex booked, any unreserved units must be turned back into the hotel inventory **on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018**. It is a **"Must"** that you book
