This scholarship, valued at \$6,000.00 is paid over the fall and winter semesters of each year with the recipient receiving \$3,000.00 each semester. To receive the second payment, the recipient must pass all courses and maintain a minimum 80% average during the fall semester.

This scholarship is awarded to a University of Regina student who is registered for full time studies (minimum of 12 credit hours), entering the final year of study in a program leading to a Bachelor of Fine Arts with a major in Indian Fine Arts, Theatre or Visual Arts, Bachelor of Music, Bachelor of Music Education or a Bachelor of Science with a major in Biology, Chemistry or Computer Science. Must be a Saskatchewan High School graduate and have maintained a minimum 80% average in all courses during the third university year of study to be eligible. The recipient will not be eligible for any other scholarship during the term of this scholarship.
